TODAY'S EPIC STORY: HEZEKIAH

2 KINGS 18:1-8;
20:1-11

THE STORY @ HOME

Hezekiah became king and trusted God, followed Him, and kept all of God's commands. In today's Epic story, we learned that Hezekiah tore down the other idols and was successful in the things he did. When Hezekiah was old, he became sick. God sent the prophet Isaiah to tell Hezekiah that he was going to die. Hezekiah prayed and cried out to God. God heard Hezekiah's prayer and healed him. Hezekiah lived for fifteen more years.
